This year's edition of the popular historical cemetery tour will spotlight the 150th anniversary of the Civil War.

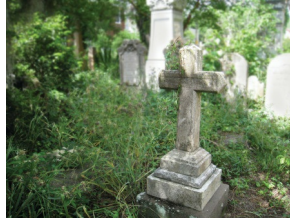
